## CHILDREN'S MESSAGE:

### **OLD TESTAMENT: 1 Kings 10:1-10**

Reader: In this reading, the African queen from Sheba travels to learn from Solomon's Wisdom. She wants to learn to better serve her people. What she hears leads her to give praise to the God of Israel and to give a huge gift to support the people of God.

Reader: **10** The queen of Sheba heard about Solomon's fame connected with the name of the LORD and came to test him with difficult questions. **2** She came to Jerusalem with a very large entourage, with camels bearing spices, gold in great abundance, and precious stones. She came to Solomon and spoke to him about everything that was on her mind. **3** So Solomon answered all her questions; nothing was too difficult for the king to explain to her. **4** When the queen of Sheba observed all of Solomon's wisdom, the palace he had built, **5** the food at his table, his servants' residence, his attendants' service and their attire, his cupbearers, and the burnt offerings he offered at the LORD's temple, it took her breath away.

**6** She said to the king, "The report I heard in my own country about your words and about your wisdom is true. **7** But I didn't believe the reports until I came and saw with my own eyes. Indeed, I was not even told half. Your wisdom and prosperity far exceed the report I heard. **8** How happy are your men. How happy are these servants of yours, who always stand in your presence hearing your wisdom. **9** Blessed be the LORD your God! He delighted in you and put you on the throne of Israel, because of the LORD's eternal love for Israel. He has made you king to carry out justice and righteousness."

<sup>10</sup> Then she gave the king four and a half tons of gold, a great quantity of spices, and precious stones. Never again did such a quantity of spices arrive as those the queen of Sheba gave to King Solomon.

Reader: This is the Word of the Lord.

### **PSALM 92 - A psalm. A song for the Sabbath day.**

Reader: In this ancient Hebrew Faith Poem the poet celebrates the wonderful things the Lord has done for him in contrast with God's judgment on evil doers.

and your faithfulness at night,

<sup>3</sup> with a ten-stringed harp  
and the music of a lyre.

<sup>4</sup> For you have made me rejoice, Lord,  
by what you have done;

I will shout for joy  
because of the works of your hands.

<sup>5</sup> How magnificent are your works, Lord,  
how profound your thoughts!

<sup>6</sup> A stupid person does not know,  
a fool does not understand this:

<sup>7</sup> though the wicked sprout like grass  
and all evildoers flourish,  
they will be eternally destroyed.

<sup>8</sup> But you, Lord, are exalted forever.

<sup>9</sup> For indeed, Lord, your enemies—  
indeed, your enemies will perish;  
all evildoers will be scattered.

<sup>10</sup> You have lifted up my horn  
like that of a wild ox;  
I have been anointed with the finest oil.

<sup>11</sup> My eyes look at my enemies;  
when evildoers rise against me,  
my ears hear them.

<sup>12</sup> The righteous thrive like a palm tree  
and grow like a cedar tree in Lebanon.

<sup>13</sup> Planted in the house of the Lord,  
they thrive in the courts of our God.

<sup>14</sup> They will still bear fruit in old age,  
healthy and green,

<sup>15</sup> to declare, “The Lord is just;  
he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him.”

Reader: This is the Word of the Lord.

#### **EPISTLE (LETTER): *1 Timothy 1:1-5***

Reader: As Paul starts this letter to Timothy, he reminds him that his grandmother and mother taught him the faith that he now holds.

Reader Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by God's will, for the sake of the promise of life in Christ Jesus:

<sup>2</sup> To Timothy, my dearly loved son.

Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

<sup>3</sup> I thank God, whom I serve with a clear conscience as my ancestors did, when I constantly remember you in my prayers night and day. <sup>4</sup> Remembering your tears, I long to see you so that I may be filled with joy. <sup>5</sup> I recall your sincere faith that first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and now, I am convinced, is in you also.

Reader: This is the Word of the Lord.

**People: Thanks be to God.**

#### **HOLY GOSPEL: *Luke 10:38-42***

Reader: In today's Special Good News, Jesus celebrates Mary's decision to learn as his disciple. Martha is concerned that Mary is not following the normally expected social conventions but Jesus will not stop Mary from her desire to learn God's word.

Reader: <sup>38</sup> While they were traveling, he entered a village, and a woman named Martha welcomed him into her home. <sup>39</sup> She had a sister named Mary, who also sat at the Lord's feet and was listening to what he said. <sup>40</sup> But Martha was distracted by her many tasks, and she came up and asked, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to serve alone? So tell her to give me a hand."

<sup>41</sup> The Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and upset about many things, <sup>42</sup> but one thing is necessary. Mary has made the right choice, and it will not be taken away from her."

Reader: This is the Special Good News of the Lord.
